

Spider Extraction Device

The six-person Spider Extraction Device is designed to safely and efficiently move up to six rescuers or appropriately packaged survivors over a short distance using short-haul techniques via a medium to large helicopter. This device accelerates rescues and reduces risk by eliminating excessive movements to and from a hazardous location.

COMPONENT SPECIFICATIONS

Color: Black webbing
Bright yellow top cover - black bottom cover

CLEANING

Submerge in solution of laundry detergent and non-salt water. Rinse and hang to dry thoroughly before storage.

Center Covers:

Top: 1000 denier nylon Cordura, bright yellow

Bottom: 1000 denier nylon Cordura, black

Reflective Tape: 2-1/4" wide heat-on reflective ribbon

Color coded red, white, blue, yellow

Main Strap (Load bearing): Type XXVI, Class 1A, PIA-W-4088 nylon webbing with resin-impregnated IAW PIA-W-27265; 15,000 break strength minimum
